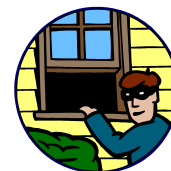

- Let trusted neighbours know when you are away.

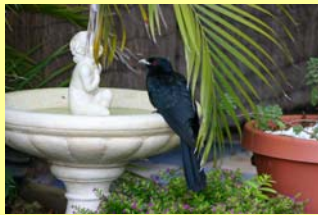
Remember: Unlocked doors and windows are an open invitation to burglars.
